

Who Am I?

DT (Design Technology):

- Research fashion styles and create a mood board and final plan (exploded diagram).
- Use running stitch and backstitch to create own customised t-shirt – sewing embellishments onto it.

Prior learning: Sewing Roman purses using running stitch (Year 3 Romans).



PSHE (Personal, Social & Health Education):

- Identify inspiring personal traits of icons (focusing on David Attenborough, Marcus Rashford and JK Rowling) and relate them to own aspirations.
- Discuss famous icons over time and how they have changed perceptions of gender and race – focusing on Martin Luther King and Emmeline Pankhurst.

Prior learning: PSHE SCARF curriculum in each year group – particularly 'Valuing Difference' and 'Rights & Responsibilities' topics.

Art:

- Create a contrasting portrait in the style of Picasso, using paint.

Prior learning: Portraits of Boudicca (Year 3 Romans).

- Develop use of tone to enhance features on a self-portrait sketch.

Prior learning: Self-portraits focusing on positioning of features (Year 1 Paint A Rainbow).

Vocabulary:

Icon: An inspirational person, worthy of admiration.

Legacy: The lost-lasting memory and influence of a person.

Inspirational: Making you feel hopeful, encouraged or motivated.

Discrimination: When someone is treated differently (not in a good way) because of some aspect of their identity.

Cubism: Art in which subjects are broken up into different sections and painted from different perspectives and angles.
