Year 1 Themes	<u>Paint a Rainbow</u> Children learn about primary and secondary colours, colour mixing and the work of Matisse and Alma Thomas. They create collages in the style of Matisse and they consider their selection of brushes and development of different strokes to create a painted artwork in the style of Thomas.	<u>Festivals</u> Children learn about Diwali, including the story of Rama and Sita and they use clay to make a Diva lamp. They produce fireworks artwork using paint and glitter. They learn about the Jewish celebration of Hannukah. When learning about Christmas, they learn about the importance of light and Advent.	<u>Playtime</u> Children learn about how toys have changed over history. They have a theme day with special visitors in school. They also learn about different materials toys can be made from and design and make their own roly poly toy and felt hand puppet.	<u>Here We Are</u> In this theme, children learn about the beauty of our planet and our solar system. They celebrate the diversity of the human race when looking back at human achievement, including the 1969 moon landing and more recently the achievements of British astronaut Tim Peake. They consider what the past is and think about how old our planet is, going right back to dinosaurs and how that relates to where they are today. They begin to develop skills using pastels to create art work when making a solar system and when producing a moonscape.	<u>If I Go Down to the Woods Today</u> Children begin to develop their map skills by looking at aerial imagery and creating their own maps with a simple key. They learn about the different parts of a plant and develop our observational and sketching skills when sketching a flower. They create a sculpture in the style of Andy Goldsworthy using natural materials. Children use a modelling material (playdough) to create a sculpture of a flower.	<u>I Do Like to be Beside the Seaside</u> Children learn about safety at the beach and the physical geographical features of a beach. They explore and make a sliding mechanism when making a picture of the beach. They develop their food preparation skills when making a healthy sandwich for the Lighthouse Keeper. They visit the beach and create sea artwork using a range of media.
