History

- To be able to place the Roman period on a timeline

Prior learning: Learnt about the Stone Age to Iron Age in Year 3 and made a physical timeline on the field. In Year 2 you learnt about the Great Fire of London. Can you remember when and where it started? In Year 1, you learnt about the Queen and Neil Armstrong. How long ago was that?

- To understand why the Romans invaded different countries
- To know about the Roman Army and why they were so successful
- To understand how Britain defended itself against the Romans

This is the first time you have learnt about conflict in History. Can you think why you haven't learnt about it yet?

- To know about Boudicca and the role she played in defending Britain

Prior Learning: In Year 1 you learnt about historical figures including Queen Elizabeth II and Neil Armstrong. Why were they important figures?

Design Technology

- To make a Roman purse using running stitch

Prior learning: In Year 1 you used running stitch to make a hand puppet. In Year 2 you learnt overstitch to create a butterfly. Can you remember what these stitches looked like or how to do them?

Geography

- To understand why the Romans invaded and where the Roman Empire spread over Europe. To be able to identify Rome, Italy and Great Britain

Prior learning: In Year 2 you learnt the seven continents. Can you remember them? Which continent is the UK and Italy in?

Art

- To create a portrait of Boudicca using paints and paint mixing

Prior learning: In Year 2 you painted a timber house in the Fire of London. In Year 1, you painted a portrait of Queen Elizabeth II. You also learnt about colour mixing. In our Art Attack theme you painted Can you think what colours you would need to mix to make a skin colour?

- Design and make a Roman shield

Prior learning: In year two and earlier in year three we researched, designed and combined different materials to make our dioramas. What could you use to make different textures in your work?
