Summary of PPG spending 2019/20

Objectives in spending PPG and summary of spending and actions taken:

Current issues:

Increase in EAL pupils in Foundation Stage 28% of pupils. Maintain hours to accommodate rise in EAL pupils. KS2 focus group to be targeted by specified LSA in Literacy / SPAG – subsequent increase in hours.

Progress of targeted PPG pupils in Y5 to be supported by Inclusion Manager (those at risk of not making progress based on analysis of last year's data).

SENCO- training of member of staff working on National SENCo Award – focus on pupil voice, communication with community.

In line with DfE recommendations with regards to Mental Health and Wellbeing provision in schools document (October 2018) Play Therapy & Pastoral Support Manager to continue to support vulnerable pupils. Thrive Approach rolled out across school (Whole school inset Sept 2019 – linked to LSA performance management target) used to support and monitor vulnerable pupils emotional development. SCARF to be further prompted through its use in assemblies and as a scheme of work for PSHE.

Continue to promote high attendance as part of a positive work ethos across the school.
