Communication and Language

To begin to understand question words and use them to clarify understanding.

Talk using their ideas in full sentences using different tenses.

Prior learning - beginning to use connectives in sentences, listening to and responding to multistep instructions.

Understanding the world

Know some similarities and differences between things in the past and now—Dinosaurs

Know some similarities and differences between the natural world around them and contrasting environments—oceans,

Prior learning - learning about spring and how things grow and change including themselves since being a baby. Understanding the past by sequencing school events this year.

Personal and Social and Emotional Development:

Follow multistep instructions.

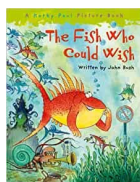
Understand the feelings of others and regulate their behaviour.

Prior learning—thinking about how others might feel.

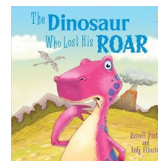
Literacy

Learning all set 1 diagraphs th, ch, sh, nk, ng, ck, qu, ss, ll, ff,.

Form all letters correctly and begin to write longer words using their phonic knowledge.



Demonstrate understanding of what has been read to them by retelling stories and narratives using their own words and recently introduced vocabulary.



Prior learning - Learning all single sounds and blending them to make a word. Writing some red tricky words in sentences.

Physical Development

Gross motor - Outdoor PE ball skills and Sports day practise.

Develop confidence, competence and accuracy when using a ball and run with confidence in a game.

Fine Motor

Correct tripod pencil grip. Beginning to show accuracy when drawing and forming letters and numbers correctly. Hold and use scissors correctly.

Prior learning—confidently and safely use a range of large and small apparatus indoors and outside, alone and in a group. Develop overall body-strength, balance, co-ordination and agility.

Mathematics

Subtraction of numbers up to 10 using practical resources.

Begin to understand and build numbers up to 20.

Positional language e.g. on, under, next to, behind, middle.

Prior learning - A good understanding and forming numbers up to 9. Knowing number bonds and doubles to 5. Odd and even numbers

Using salt dough to make shapes and impressions

Making mythical creature collages

Prior learning - painting using a range of colours. Crafts using a variety of materials: junk modelling, chalk, pastels, paint, playdough.
